

PSA 841.500 ng/ml !

To the Editor

In TMJ's 2019; 19(2): 444-445, I reported a series of progressively elevated PSA during the five-year follow-up period of an apparently healthy 73 years old business tycoon, and in 2020, October -December issue, pages 341, I reported the follow-up test showing further PSA rising to 60.170 ng/ml. Today, June 22, 2022, the man went for another test at the Department of Pathology, Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital (HN. 5262273). The result of the test indicated a rising of PSA level to 841.500 ng/ml.

I write this letter to seek help to explain the consecutive rising of serial PSA levels in this apparently healthy person.
